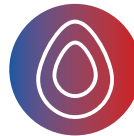

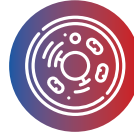
DIABETIC KIDNEY

Our specialists treat Lupus Nephritis using medications that suppress the immune system, so that it stops attacking and damaging the kidneys.



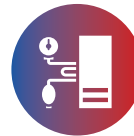
VASCULAR DISORDERS
